
Presented to the Mayor and Councilors were the following Discussion/Action Topics:

1. Acceptance of Quitclaim Deed from Gallup Land Partners, LLC – George Kozeliski, City Attorney


Mr. Kozeliski said the proposed quitclaim deed is for 1.2 acres of land being donated to the City of Gallup by Gallup Land Partners, LLC. The newly acquired property will be used for the new alignment of Allison Road and the soon to be constructed Allison Bridge. The parcel of land is part of the right-of-way that must be owned by the City before the New Mexico Department of Transportation will allow the project to go out for bid.

Councilor Palochak made the motion to accept the Quitclaim Deed from Gallup Land Partners, LLC. Seconded by Councilor Garcia. Roll call: Councilor Palochak, Garcia, Kumar, Landavazo and Mayor McKinney all voted yes.
