

## NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC

**The City of Gallup, a New Mexico municipal corporation, hereby gives notice as follows:**

- 1) The City of Gallup is the owner of Red Rock Park f/k/a Red Rock State Park in Gallup, New Mexico, being Section 11, Township 15 North, Range 17 West, N.M.P.M. and said park was built partially with United States Government Land and Water Conservation Funds as Project 35-00995;
- 2) Red Rock Park f/k/a Red Rock State Park, Section 11, T15N, R17W, N.M.P.M. was encumbered as being Land Water Conservation Fund (LWCF) land;
- 3) The City of Gallup has exchanged the LWCF designation on Red Rock Park f/k/a Red Rock State Park consisting of 623.62 acres being Section 11, Township 15 North, Range 17 West, N.M.P.M. for property owned by the City of Gallup, commonly referred to as the Gallup Motor Cross Park consisting of 765.08 acres located in Sections 1, Section 11, Section 12, Township 15 North, Range 18 West, N.M.P.M., McKinley County, New Mexico.
- 4) Attached hereto and made a part hereof as "Exhibit A" is a true and correct copy of a document entitled "Amendment to Project Agreement" for Project 35-00995, approving the transfer of the LWFC designation by the United States of America and the State of New Mexico.
- 5) Attached hereto and made a part hereof as "Exhibit B" is a true and correct copy of a letter dated 20 May, 2011, from the United States Department of Interior National Park Service indicating approval of the Land Water Conservation Fund project to the new real property owned by the City of Gallup.

Project Amendment No. 1

AMENDMENT TO PROJECT AGREEMENT

**THIS AMENDMENT To Project Agreement No. 35-00995 is hereby made and agreed upon by the United States of America, acting through the Director of the National Park Service and by the State of New Mexico pursuant to the Land and Water Conservation Fund Act of 1965, 78 Stat. 897 (1964).**

**The State and the United States, in mutual consideration of the promises made herein and in the agreement of which this is an amendment, do promise as follows:**

**That the above mentioned agreement is amended by adding the following:**

Swap 623.62 +/- acres affected by the total conversion of Red Rock Park, Gallup, NM; and replace with 765.08 +/- acres; replacement parcel will be developed initially as the Gallup Motorcross Park for ATV/OHV activities, with other planned outdoor recreation features to be added later. The City of Gallup Parks and Recreation Department will be the sponsoring agency for the recreation area.

Compliance with Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966 has been completed for the proposed ATV/OHV motorcross development taking place on the property. However, "No further ground-disturbing activities will take place on the rest of the site until the proposed construction is reviewed by the State Historic Preservation Officer in compliance with Section 106 of the NHPA of 1966."

**In all other respects the agreement of which this is an amendment, and the plans and specifications relevant thereto, shall remain in full force and effect. In witness thereof the parties hereto have executed this amendment as of the date entered below.**

Dear Mr. Mondary:

Reference is made to your May 3 correspondence regarding Land and Water Conservation Fund project 35-00995, Red Rock State Park. We concur with your recommendation for approval of the section 6(f)(3) conversion of the entire park and the replacement land. Accordingly, we have approved the amendment.

The approved amendment deleted 623 +/- acres from Red Rock State Park and replaces the converted parkland with approximately 765 acres which is located northeast of Gallup, McKinley, New Mexico.

We would like to take this opportunity to remind you that compliance to Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966, as amended, must be completed prior to any development taking place. Accordingly, the following special condition is added to the project agreement/amendment: "No ground-disturbing activities can take place on the property until the proposed construction is reviewed by the State Historic Preservation Officer and a determination of no adverse effects will result in accordance with Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966." Please notify this office with a copy of the State Historic Preservation Officer's letter of effect.

With this approval letter, all necessary actions related to this conversion are now complete.
