

Will accept -aluminum, tin/steel cans, corrugated cardboard, brown paper bags, mixed paper\*, #1 & #2 plastics\*, **all types of batteries**, electronics that ran on batteries or have cords such as computer monitors, flat screen TVs, small appliances. Old heavy, glass TVs are not recyclable.

Drop-Off fee for **large appliances**: 300 lbs or less is \$7; more if heavier.


