

**CITY OF GALLUP
MUNICIPAL OFFICER ELECTION
DISTRICTS 1 & 3**

The Municipal Officer Election will be held on **Tuesday, March 1, 2022**. Voters from Districts 1 and 3 will elect a City Councilor to serve a four year term.

Absentee and early voting will be conducted at Gallup City Hall, located at 110 West Aztec Avenue. Office hours are Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. (Closed Presidents' Day, February 21st).

Voters may call the City Clerk's Office at 863-1254 to request an absentee ballot by mail. The last day to request an absentee ballot is Thursday, February 24th at 5:00 p.m.

Early voting will be conducted during regular business hours through Friday, February 25th at 5:00 p.m. Early voting will also be held on Saturday, February 26th from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Same day voter registration will be available during early voting; however, it will not be available on Election Day.

Polls on Election Day will open at 7:00 A.M. and close at 7:00 P.M. The following locations have been designated as Voting Convenience Centers:

1. Southside Fire Station #1, 1800 South Second Street.
2. Northside Fire Station #2, 911 West Lincoln Avenue.
4. Larry Brian Mitchell Recreation Center, 700 Joseph M. Montoya Blvd.
5. McKinley County Courthouse Rotunda, 207 West Hill Avenue.

Voters will be allowed to cast their ballot at the Voting Convenience Center of their choice on Election Day. Voters will not be assigned to a specific polling place.
